Suggestions for LLAGNY members posting to Social Media sites

DOs:

- Share news and content related to LLAGNY as an organization and encourage participation in LLAGNY events, conferences, and initiatives.
- Share content, including articles and images, related to professional development, legal issues, law firms, outsourcing, research, and training.
- Like and comment on LLAGNY member postings. Connect to LLAGNY members you know.
- Committee chair members: follow Twitter accounts of other LLAGNY members, vendors, partners and relevant librarian/info pro influencers. Re-Tweet and comment on their Tweets if that content fits into the above categories.

DON'Ts:

- Discuss your employer or any confidential information regarding vendor contracts.
- Use offensive language, inflammatory statements, profanity, promote any illegal activities, or encourage violation of any law or copyright rights.
- Make political statements or endorsements, save those comments for your personal accounts. Endorse individuals running for office in LLAGNY or any professional organization.
- Promote personal, social or political agendas unrelated to LLAGNY or the informational profession, save those comments for your personal accounts.

Bottom line test – if you would not want your parents or children to read what you wrote, or would not want what you said on the front page of your local paper, or brought to the public's attention in 20 years; then don't write it.
